Biblical Psalms

Psalm 92

- 1 It is a good thing to give thanks unto the Lord * and to sing praises
unto thy Name, O most Highest.
- 2 To tell of thy loving-kindness early in the morning * and of thy truth
in the night-season.
- 3 Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the lute * upon a loud
instrument, and upon the harp.

- 4 For thou, Lord, hast made me glad through thy works * and I will rejoice in giving praise for the operations of thy hands.
- 5 O Lord, how glorious are thy works * thy thoughts are very deep.
- 6 An unwise man doth not well consider this * and a fool doth not understand it.
- 7 When the ungodly are green as the grass, and when all the workers of wickedness do flourish * then shall they be destroyed for ever; but thou, Lord, art the most Highest for evermore.
- 8 For lo, thine enemies, O Lord, lo, thine enemies shall perish * and all the workers of wickedness shall be destroyed.
- 9 But mine horn shall be exalted like the horn of an unicorn * for I am anointed with fresh oil.
- 10 Mine eye also shall see his lust of mine enemies * and mine ear shall hear his desire of the wicked that arise up against me.
- 11 The righteous shall flourish like a palm-tree * and shall spread abroad like a cedar in Libanus.
- 12 Such as are planted in the house of the Lord * shall flourish in the courts of the house of our God.
- 13 They also shall bring forth more fruit in their age * and shall be fat and well-liking.
- 14 That they may shew how true the Lord my strength is * and that there is no unrighteousness in him.

At the conclusion of the Psalm say:

Glory to God, Creator, Redeemer, Consoler and Our Saviour.

As it was in the beginning, is now and shall be forevermore. Amen.

Intercessions (required)
